


- 5 Red Rock Lookout, Radium 1.5km N of mill pond on Red Rock Rd. Eagles, waterfowl
- 6 Horsethief Ck. Rd., rock bluff S of creek about 20 km W of Radium Harris' Sparrow, thrushes
- 7 Dry Gulch Provincial Park Forest birds
- 8 Ritchie's Point, 4 km N of Wilmer Waterfowl, Solitaires, Sparrows, Ravens
